- 1. There may be a risk that the contents of your consultations could be leaked if an account gets hacked. The staff of the Nagaoka City International Affairs Center will always keep the safety of your consultations in mind. However, the Nagaoka City International Affairs Center will have no obligation for any damage or to compensate for damage caused to the consultees by hackers, disasters, or power failures.
- 2. When consulting via Skype, you must follow the Skype Terms of Use.
- 3. Do not record any images, video, or sounds of Skype consultations.
- 4. When consulting via Skype, do not include any personal information or contents that you do not want to let other people know. For your confidential matters, it is best to visit the Nagaoka City International Affairs Center in person.
